CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT GRANT (CIG)

WHAT IS IT?

The Capital Improvement Grant (CIG) Program is designed to support capital projects that enhance public infrastructure within the DDA District and deliver clear, measurable public benefit.

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS MAY INCLUDE:

- ✔ Lighting
- ✔ Awnings & Canopies
- ✔ Accessibility & Public Interface Improvements
- ✔ Streetscape Enhancements (if directly related to the property)

GRANT DETAILS:

- 50/50 Matching Grant
- Reimbursement-based (proof of payment required)
- Must use licensed contractors
- The project must be completed within 12 months of the award unless otherwise approved

STEP-BY-STEP & REQUIREMENTS

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- ✔ Pre-Application Meeting
- ✔ Application Submission
- ✔ Staff Review
- ✔ Board Approval
- ✔ Agreement & Execution
- ✔ Implementation & Reimbursement

REMINDER

- All projects require DDA Board approval.
- Funding is not guaranteed and is subject to eligibility and budget.

- Program not eligible for work that has already begun.
- The application must be submitted and approved first.
- Work must be completed by licensed contractors with all required permits.
- Proof of insurance and a 5-year easement agreement with the DDA is required.
- Submit two (2) vendor estimates to ensure competitive pricing.
- All improvements must be completed within 12 months unless otherwise approved.
- Changes to project scope/cost must be reapproved by the DDA Board.
- Funding decisions must align with Article 15 of the Wyoming Constitution and state law.
